## RULES OF PLAY

- The Rotary Bonspiel will be played under the rules of the Canadian Curling Club association for general play.
- The 5 Rock rule/free guard zone is in effect.
- All games are 8 ends (After bell complete the end and 1 more).
- All regular round robin games must be completed within the allocated 2-hour timeframe. When the bell sounds, complete that End and 1 More End.
- In the event of a tie during round robin play, skips shall draw to the button with sweepers.
- In the event of a tie during playoff games, the teams shall play extra ends.
- Winning teams are to record win/loss on the master score sheet situated in the Curling club lobby.
- A hog bell and Donation box will be situated on both ends of the sheets with $\$ 1.00$ voluntary contribution to Secret 3 K Marathon for hogged stones during round robin games.
- All questions or disputes will be addressed to Collin Georget \& Vern Boyd and their decision will be final.
- Best of luck to all! Hurry hard;).


## Format

- Following the completion of the first game played all 4 team members shall draw to the button with sweepers. Team skill points will be tallied on the team sheets provided. The points tallied will be utilized for tie breakers in the round robin standings.
- Teams in all pools will play a 3-game round robin in their pool.
- After the round robin, teams will be ranked 1-4 in their pools based on W/L and head-to-head record with ties broken via team skill points.
- The top teams in each of the six pools and the 2 highest ranked \#2 teams from all pools, 8 teams total, will qualify for the ' $A$ ' division playoffs. The ' $A$ ' winner will be declared the Bonspiel Champion.
- The remaining \#2 teams and the 2 highest ranked \#3 teams from all pools, 6 teams total, will qualify for the 'B' division playoffs.
- The remaining \#3 teams and the 2 highest ranked \#4 teams from all pools, 6 teams total, will qualify for the ' C ' division playoffs.
- In this manner, 20 of the 24 teams registered will advance to a single knock-out competition in the $A, B$, or $C$ event playoffs.
